1. SCHOOL UNIFORM/LEARNER APPEARANCE

We urge you to make sure that your child is cleanly and neatly dressed every day; therefore, please follow these guidelines/rules to ensure that your child's appearance reflects the standard of our school.

School uniform,

- Instills pride in the school
- Encourages identification with allied school
- Promotes a sense of equality amongst students
- Gives students a sense of belonging
- Increases safety while walking to and from school or on excursions, making identification of stud

2. SCHOOL UNIFORM

2.1. Girls

- Tunic dress (grade 1-12)
- School golf shirts (grade1-12)
- Gils school grey trousers
- white shirt with school logo
- Pull-over / jersey with school logo
- School Blazer with school logo

- Muslim female learners may only wear a plain navy blue scarf

3. HAIR STYLES

3.1. Girls

- Only blue and white bands or hair ribbons are permitted- no fancy clips or slides
- Clean, neat and tidy. No extensions or weaves. Braids /cornrows must be plaited to the head- not allowing hang. Long hair must be pulled back. Hair may not fall forward to the face.
- Girls with pierced ears may wear studs only
- No nail polish may be worn
- Muslim girls may only wear navy blue scarfs
- Black school shoes
- School grey schools
- Black or white sports shoes may be won for sports purposes only

3.2. Boys

- No jewelry other than wrist watches and medic alert bracelets may be worn to school
- Boys may not wear earrings
- Boys hair must be neat & tidy and may not be plaited
- Black school shoes
- Black or white sports shoes may be won for sports purposes only

4. GENERAL APPEARANCE/ GUIDELINES/RULES

- Finger nails must be short
- Shoes must be polished
- School bags must be clean
- If a t-shirt is worn under the school shirt it must not be visible above any portion of the shirt
- Beanies are not to be worn in class
- Underwear items e.g. boxer shorts must not be visible
- Pants must be worn properly and not hang below the hip line
- Proper hygiene is very important
- Towels/blankets may not be worn over the uniform.
- A blue scarf and blue gloves may be worn on cold days
- No makeup
- Shirts must be tucked in.
